- Opening Prayer & review of last month's minutes.
- Financial Report by Dennis Trentman. We are still maintaining a very healthy balance sheet, approx. \$52,000. There a few outstanding small bills yet to be paid. Figures do not include upcoming fees from basketball sign-ups.
- Gym Report (Pat Longo): Have secured Evendale and Sharonville Elementary along with Stewart, which is a new location. Should have 6-9 pm slots 5 nights a week among all locations. Heritage Elementary in Springdale may an option as well. We are trying to use Sports Plus as little as possible due to costs.
- Sports Reports: **(Boy's Basketball)**: Sign-ups later this week in Gathering space after all masses. A/B selection process will be revamped. No coaches or parents allowed. (3) independent judges with AAU, college, and professional experience will be used to evaluate players over 2 nights. Discussion followed to promote the use of non-parent coaches for all "A" teams whenever possible. **(Girl's Basketball)**: no report given but season is underway. Some new scorebooks and basketballs were purchased. All uniforms were updated last season. **(Golf)**: no report given. **(Baseball)**; some new socks and pants will need to be purchased for Spring season. This was approved by Board. **(Volleyball)**: No report given but Season starts in January. **(Soccer)**: Seasons are underway. Practices seem to be working out ok. One team had 20 players on it but it's working out.
- New Trophy Case to be placed in the Cafeteria is close to being completed by Pete Heister. All past and current Coaches are advised to get any League or City Trophies to Terry Connaughton, so that they can be displayed. Trophies will be rotated if necessary due to space limitations. Cost of case was paid for by the Boosters.
- Golden Bears Football Program Discussion: Due to the future merger of OLSH with St. Nicholas Academy, St. Michael will be taking over the program that was previously run under the direction of OLSH. A meeting is scheduled with OLSH Booster members and St. Michael Booster Board about the transition and equipment inventory.
- The Board was asked by Scott Hungler if it was interested in picking up cost of a new Chair Dolly. Board decided this did not reflect its mission and opted not to pick up the cost. However, Board would consider other requests on case by case basis.
